

FUNERALS:

1) General Requirements

The deceased's next of kin must be able to verify that the deceased is a member of the Eastern Orthodox faith in order to hold a funeral in Assumption Greek Orthodox Church of Long Beach.

2) Fees

The General Requirement above having been met, specific fees based on several conditions that may exist will be charged. Such fees are generally used to maintain Church facilities and to pay the salaries of those who must participate in planning and executing the funeral service.

3) Membership Related Fees

"Members in Good Standing" is defined as: the deceased is/was a Pledged Steward of a Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of America (GOAA) member church and that they are/were meeting their pledge as promised.

- a) If the deceased is/was a "Member in Good Standing" of Assumption Greek Orthodox Church, no additional fee is required.
- b) If the deceased is/was not a "Member in Good Standing" of Assumption Greek Orthodox Church, but is/was a member of another GOAA member church, the funeral fee is **\$300**.
- c) If the deceased is/was not a "Member in Good Standing" of Assumption Greek Orthodox Church, yet regularly attend Assumption Greek Orthodox Church, the funeral service fee is **\$300**.
- d) If the deceased is/was not a "Member in Good Standing" of any GOAA member church but is a documented members of the Eastern Orthodox faith, the funeral fee is **\$300**.

4) Other Fees

- a) The chanter's fee (funeral only) is **\$150**. (check payable to George Dorlis)

- b) The maintenance fee is **\$80** (check payable to Assumption Church)
