Κάποτε μία μητέρα, ρώτησε τον μικρό γιο της να της πει, ποιο κατά τη γνώμη του ήταν το πιο σημαντικό μέρος στο σώμα μας.

Στην αρχή το αγόρι νόμισε ότι βρήκε εύκολα την απάντηση και έτρεξε στη μητέρα του όλο χαρά. Είχε ανακαλύψει τη μαγεία και την ομορφιά των ήχων και της είπε "νομίζω πως είναι τα αυτιά, με τα οποία ακούμε". Εκείνη χαμογέλασε και του είπε: "Όχι, υπάρχουν τόσοι άνθρωποι γύρω μας που δεν ακούνε, γιατί είναι κουφοί".

Σου εύχομαι να έχεις πάντα στη ζωή σου έναν τέτοιο ώμο, γεμάτο παρηγοριά για κείνους που θα κλάψουν και θα 'χουν ανάγκη τον ώμο της ανάπης σου για να νείρουν. Όταν θα το έχεις καταλάβει αυτό που σου λέω και θα συμφωνείς, τότε θα είναι σημάδι ότι έχεις μεγαλώσει αρκετά και ότι ζεις σωστά τη ζωή σου".
